

A graduate of New York University with a BA in Music, he has been music director/conductor of the original Broadway productions of *Les Misérables*, *Miss Saigon*, *Man of La Mancha* (2002 revival), *Singin' in the Rain* and *The Best Little Whorehouse in Texas*. Other Broadway productions he has conducted include *Chicago*, *Wicked*, *Song and Dance* and *My One and Only*. National tours include *Wicked*, *The D rowsy Chaperone*, *Young Frankenstein*, *Les Misérables* (25th anniversary production), *Chicago* and most recently, *Hello Dolly!*. Off-Broadway he was music director and vocal arranger for the original production of *Little Shop of Horrors* and provided the vocal arrangements for the film version of the show.
